







College Profile

Sikh National College, Charan Kanwal, Banga, is a multi-faculty, multi-discipline, co-educational institute catering to the educational needs of the suburban, rural people and the weaker sections of the society. It was established in 1953, just after 6 years of independence, with a mission to strengthen religious, social and cultural values and to inculcate patriotism among the youth. It is situated towards the east of Banga on the Chandigarh road on 8 acres of land in the vicinity of the serene environs of the precincts of Gurdwara Charan Kanwal Sahib. In 1634, Guru Hargobind Sahib Ji, the sixth saint soldier Guru of Sikhs, visited this place. To perpetuate the memory of the Guru's visit, Gurdwara Charan Kanwal Sahib was built at this place by Sher-e-Punjab Maharaja Ranjit Singh. The Maharaja who was a devout Sikh and a man of bounteous personality also donated 35 acres of land to the Gurudwara, bathed in marble whiteness, symbolizing the blend of Bhakti and Shakti, Gurudwara Charan Kanwal Sahib forms the backdrop of the college casting its spiritual splendour and pure serenity on the campus. This land has also seen the emergence of many freedom fighters. Noted amongst them are Babbar Akalis and Shaheed-e-Azam Bhagat Singh, who laid down their lives in freeing India from the shackles of slavery. The native village of Shaheed Bhagat Singh, Khatkar Kalan, is just 4 kilometers away from the college.

Sikh National College, established on this land sanctified by sages and patriots, is taking long strides towards the attainment of excellence in diverse spheres of activity under the aegis of Sikh Educational Society, Chandigarh, which was formed at Lahore in 1937. The Society established Sikh National College, Lahore, in 1937-38 and it played a pivotal role in providing education and strengthening the freedom movement. After partition, Sikh National College was relocated at Qadian in 1948. Sikh National College, Banga, was conceived and translated into reality in 1953 by dint of laudable efforts of S. Harguranad Singh, the then MLA with the avowed mission of providing quality education to the people of the rural Doaba region of Punjab. Keeping in view the dynamic role played by the Sikh Educational Society in imparting quality education and its commitment towards society, the college followed the trailblazer in letter and spirit. The Society, with its head office at Chandigarh, is the management of the institute, comprised of renowned personalities who have carved out a special niche for themselves in social circles. It is at present headed by S. Gurdev Singh Brar, IAS (Retd.) as President, Chief Er. (Retd.) S. Kulbir Singh, Former State Information Commissioner as Vice-President, Col. (Retd.) J.S. Bala as Secretary and S. Jarnail Singh Palli Jhikki as Secretary, LMC. Dr. Tarsem Singh Bhinder joined his services as Principal of the institution on May 23, 2021. The college is progressing by leaps and bounds under the guidance of these men of great acumen.

The college offers Postgraduate Degree Courses, viz., M.Sc. (Mathematics), M.Sc. (Computer Science), M.A. (Economics), M.Sc. (FD & M), M.A. (English), M.Com., M.A. (Punjabi), M.A. (History), Postgraduate Diploma Courses, viz., Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Applications, Postgraduate Diploma in Garment Construction & Fashion Designing and Postgraduate Diploma in Financial Services. It offers Undergraduate Degree Courses in Arts, Science, Commerce, Management, Economics, Computer Science, Computer Applications and Fashion Designing. The college has also made available to its students vocational subjects, viz. Functional English, Fashion Designing & Garment Construction and Computer Applications at the graduate level. In addition to it, the college also offers B.Voc./ Advanced Diploma/ Diploma in Refrigeration & Air Conditioning, Diploma in Computer Applications, Diploma in Computer Maintenance, Diploma in Professional Accountancy and Diploma in Library Science after 10+2. All departments have their well-equipped laboratories/workshops.

Since its inception, the college has got major achievements in academic, cultural and sporting fronts. At both UG and PG level examinations, the college students have bagged numerous university merit positions. On cultural front, the college Youth Festival team emerged overall champion in GNDU, Amritsar Zonal Youth Festival for year 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024. The college Bhangra team has been excelling for past several years by obtaining top position in youth festivals. At sporting front, the college students have brought laurels to the institute at state and national level. The college football team emerged victorious in GNDU Amritsar Inter-College Football Championship in 2023. The college has produced a large number of shining alumni serving as top bureaucrats, armed officers, politicians, doctors, engineers, teachers, scientists, sportspersons and social workers.

The college continues to upgrade its infrastructure as part of its commitment to ensure excellence in all spheres. Recently, the hall above the administrative block was renovated and named as Panzey Ikmindar Singh Sandhu Memorial Hall. In addition, 50 kW solar panels have been installed at a cost of around ₹20 lakh, aimed at protection and preservation of environment.

The college is re-accredited by NAAC for second cycle and the third cycle is due. The institution also runs a collegiate school that offers Humanities, Medical, Non-Medical and Commerce streams at + 1 and + 2 level.

- Toppers in the university merit list will be granted 100% concession in the total fee except university/govt. charges & university examination fee.
- Students placed in the university/board merit list will be granted 75% concession in total fee (split into two semesters).
- Students who stand first and second in their respective classes (with 1st division) will be granted concession of ₹1000/- in total fee (split into two semesters).
- Students who secure marks from 80% to 85.5%, 85.6% to 90.5%, 90.6% to 95.5% and above 95.6% in + 2 examinations will be granted concession of ₹1000/-, ₹2000/-, ₹3000/- and ₹5000/- respectively in total fee (split into two semesters).
- Students who secure marks from 80% to 85.5%, 85.6% to 90.5% and above 90.6% in matriculation examinations will be granted concession of ₹1000/-, ₹2000/- and ₹3000/- respectively in total fee.
- Real brothers or sisters or brother and sister studying in the college/collegiate school will be granted concession of ₹2000/- to any one of them in total fee for the full session. Three real brothers or sisters studying in the college/collegiate school will be granted concession of ₹5000/- to two younger ones (₹2000/- and ₹3000/- respectively, split into two semesters).
- Fatherless/Motherless students will be granted concession of ₹3000/- and parentless students will be granted concession of ₹5000/- in total fee (split into two semesters).
- Students who are permanent residents of the village Jindowal (subject to verification by the Sarpanch) will be granted concession of ₹4000/- in total fee (split into two semesters).

Academic and Co-Curricular Activities: A Concise Outline

Ardaas-cum-Annual Prize Distribution Function

Principal Dr. Tarsem Singh presented, in detail, the notable attainments of the college in the session gone by. Earth Day Observed

On April 22, 2024, under the aegis of State Nodal Agency of Punjab State Council for Science & Technology, MoEFCC, Govt. of India, Nature Eco Club and Departments of Botany & Zoology observed Earth Day by carrying out plantation of fruit saplings in the college campus. Workshop on Vermi-Composting

Botany and Zoology Departments jointly organized a workshop on Vermi-Composting under Environment Education Program, State Nodal Agency of Punjab State Council for Science & Technology, sponsored by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India and Dean Colleges Development Council, GNDU, Amritsar on April 30, 2024, in the college campus under the able guidance of Principal Dr. Tarsem Singh and coordinator of Eco Club Dr. Sunidhi Miglani. The thrust objective of the workshop was to create awareness among the masses to protect the environment by providing training on composting and vermi-composting techniques. All present staff members and more than 35 students, who attended the workshop, took the pledge to save the environment and spread awareness among their friends and families.
